Blaise was a physician, and bishop of Sebastea in historical Armenia (modern Sivas, Turkey), popularly known as the saint who protects from ailments of the throat.
According to the *Acta Sanctorum*, he was martyred by being beaten, attacked with iron combs, and beheaded.
Ansgar was a Archbishop of Hamburg-Bremen – a northern part of the Kingdom of the East Franks. The See of Hamburg was designated a mission to bring Christianity to Northern Europe, and Ansgar became known as the "Apostle of the North".

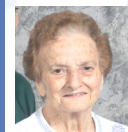

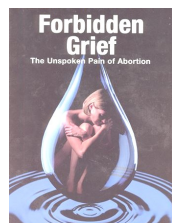
