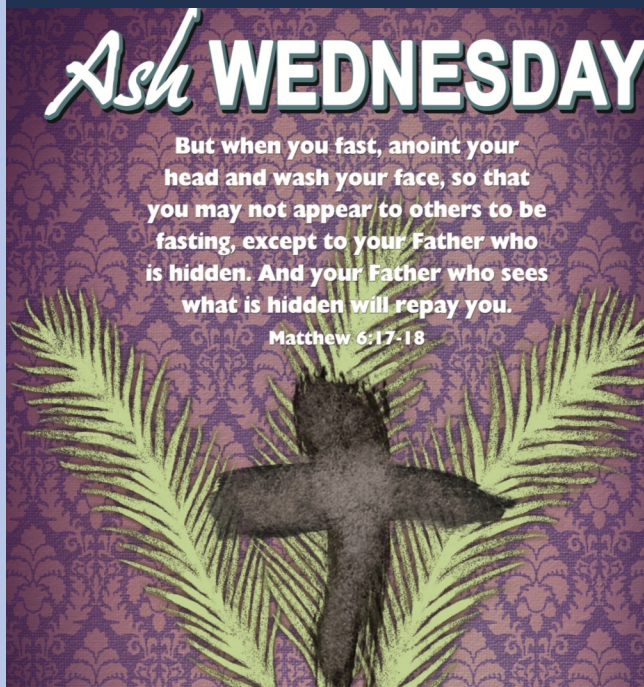

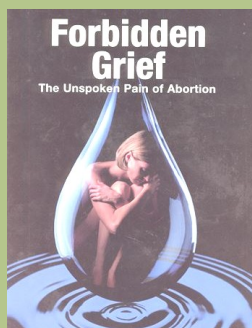

Have you considered what your wishes for your Funeral Mass will include? What readings, songs, or family participation have meaning to you?

All Catholic priests in the Diocese of Lansing are required to have their funerals pre-planned. I have been working on my own funeral in a way that will hopefully assist my family and loved ones in the grieving process while expressing the joy and peace we have in the resurrection. We believe life is changed, not ended. Therefore I hope my funeral is witness to and a celebration of faith, the gift of

life God gave me, and the joy of the Gospel.

I have done over three hundred funerals at Holy Redeemer since I have been here over the last seven and a half years. I have learned that it is probably wise, in most cases, for all parishioners to pre-plan their funerals too.

Sadly, too many families experience disputes and hard feelings when arranging a loved one's funeral. Because memories of the loved one's wishes sometimes contradict each other, disagreements can easily arise. By making your plans now, your loved ones don't have to guess at what you may have wanted; they will know you were remembered as you wanted to be.

An added advantage of being able to specify your desire for a funeral and burial in the Catholic tradition, your pre-planning becomes an act of faith, a statement of your Catholic convictions, and ensures that you will receive the sacred Catholic funeral rites supported by your faith community.

I encourage you to preplan your Funeral Mass. Write down your wishes, and share them with your family. If you would want to discuss this with someone here at the Parish, please call me at (810) 908-0800..
