but theologically rich reflections he delivered during his time as the Bishop of Ravenna.

Tuesday St. Ignatius of Loyola, Priest

He was a Spanish Basque priest and theologian, who founded the religious order called the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) and became its first Superior

General. The Jesuit order served the Pope as missionaries, and they were bound by a vow of special obedience to the sovereign pontiff in regard to the missions. They therefore emerged as an important force during the time of the Counter-Reformation.

St Alphonsus Liguori, **Bishop & Church Doctor**

He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer Redemptorists). A prolific writer, he

published nine editions of his Moral Theology in his lifetime, in addition to other devotional and ascetic works and letters. Among his best known works are The Glories of Mary and The Way of the Cross.

St. Eusebius of Vercelli, Bishop; St. Peter Julian Eymard, Priest Jer 18:1-6:

He was an Italian bishop. Along with Athanasius, he affirmed the divinity of Jesus against Arianism.



Peter Evmard was a French Catholic priest and founder of two religious institutes: the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament for men and the Servants of the Blessed Sacrament for women.
